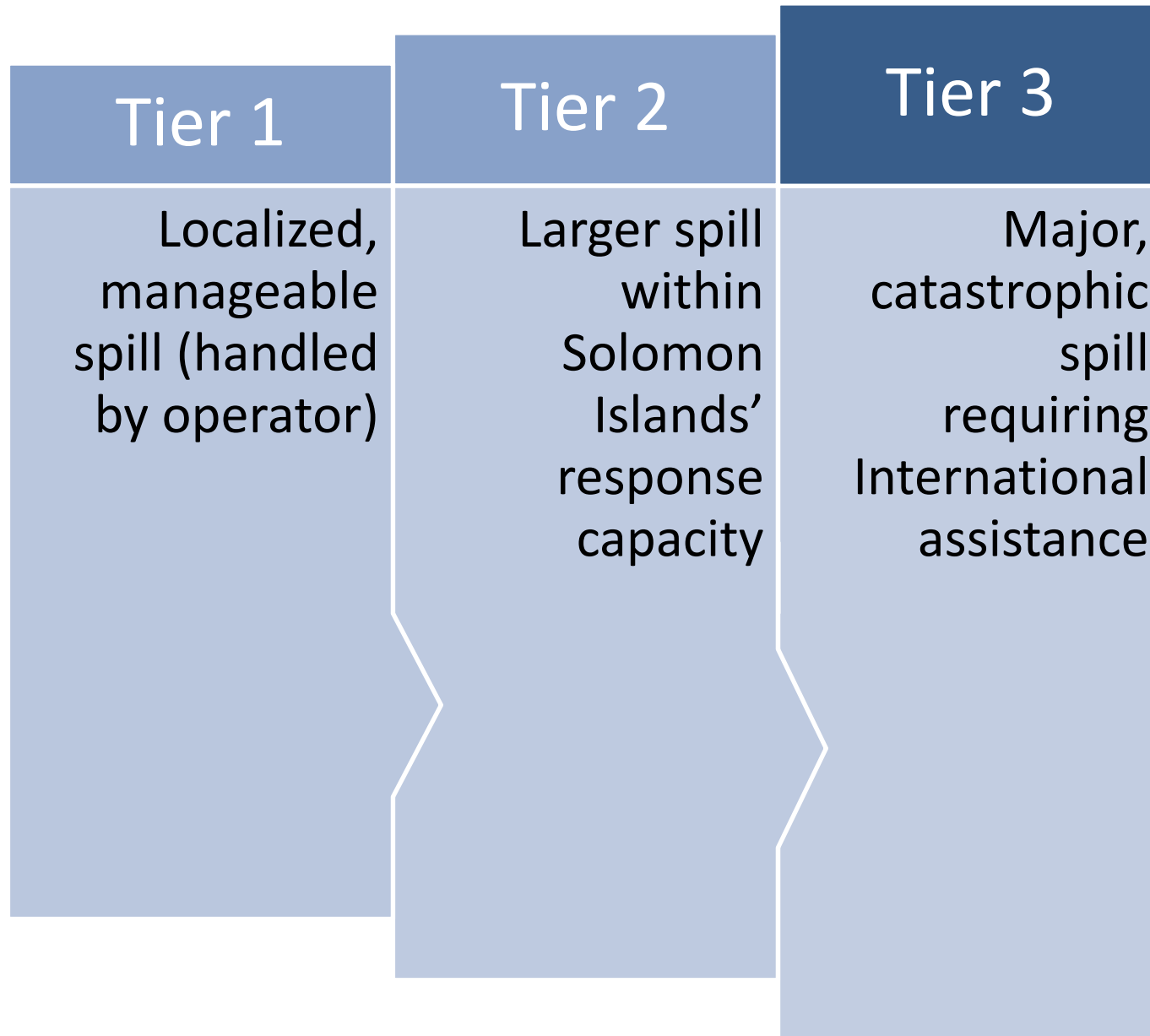

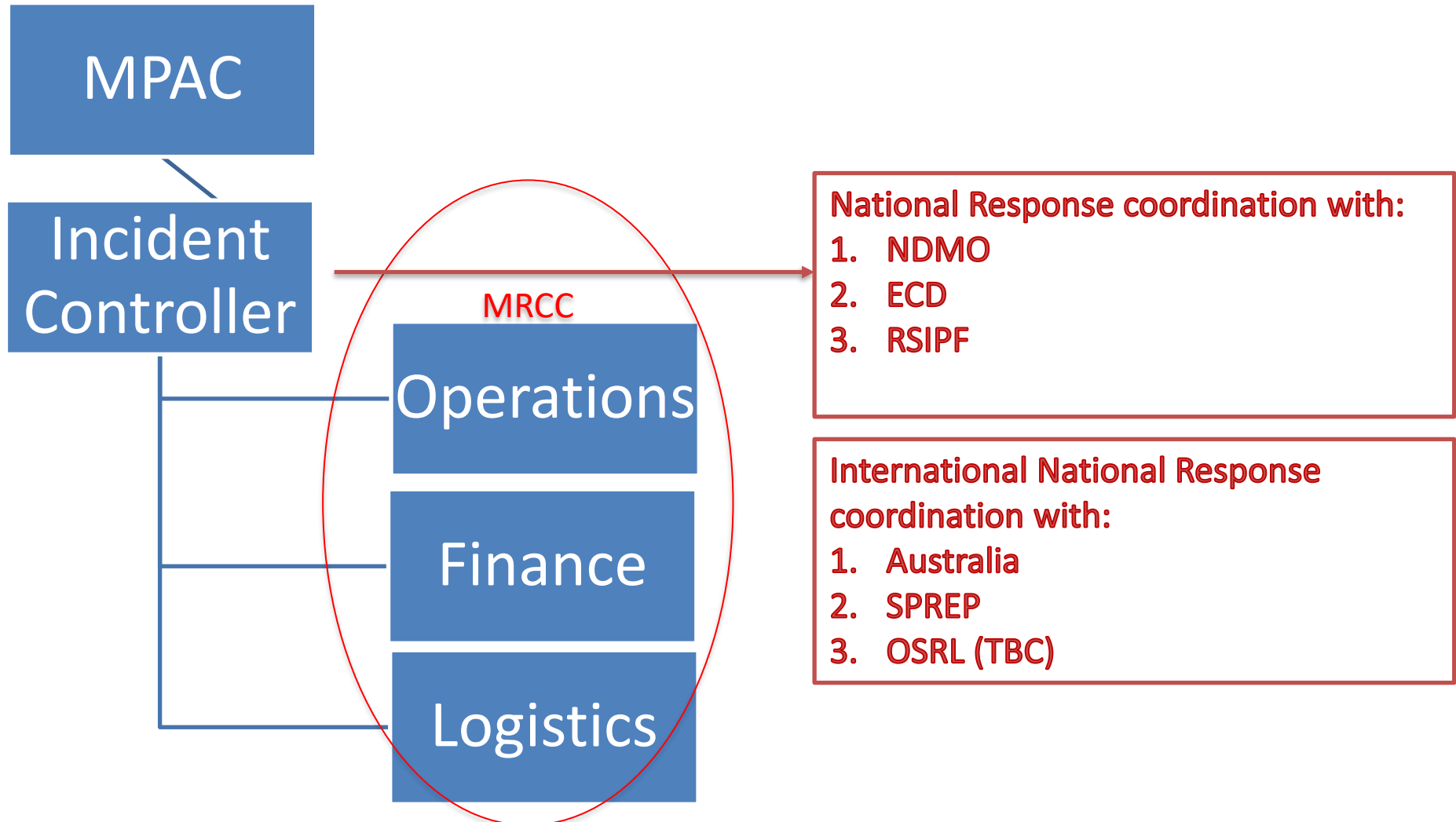

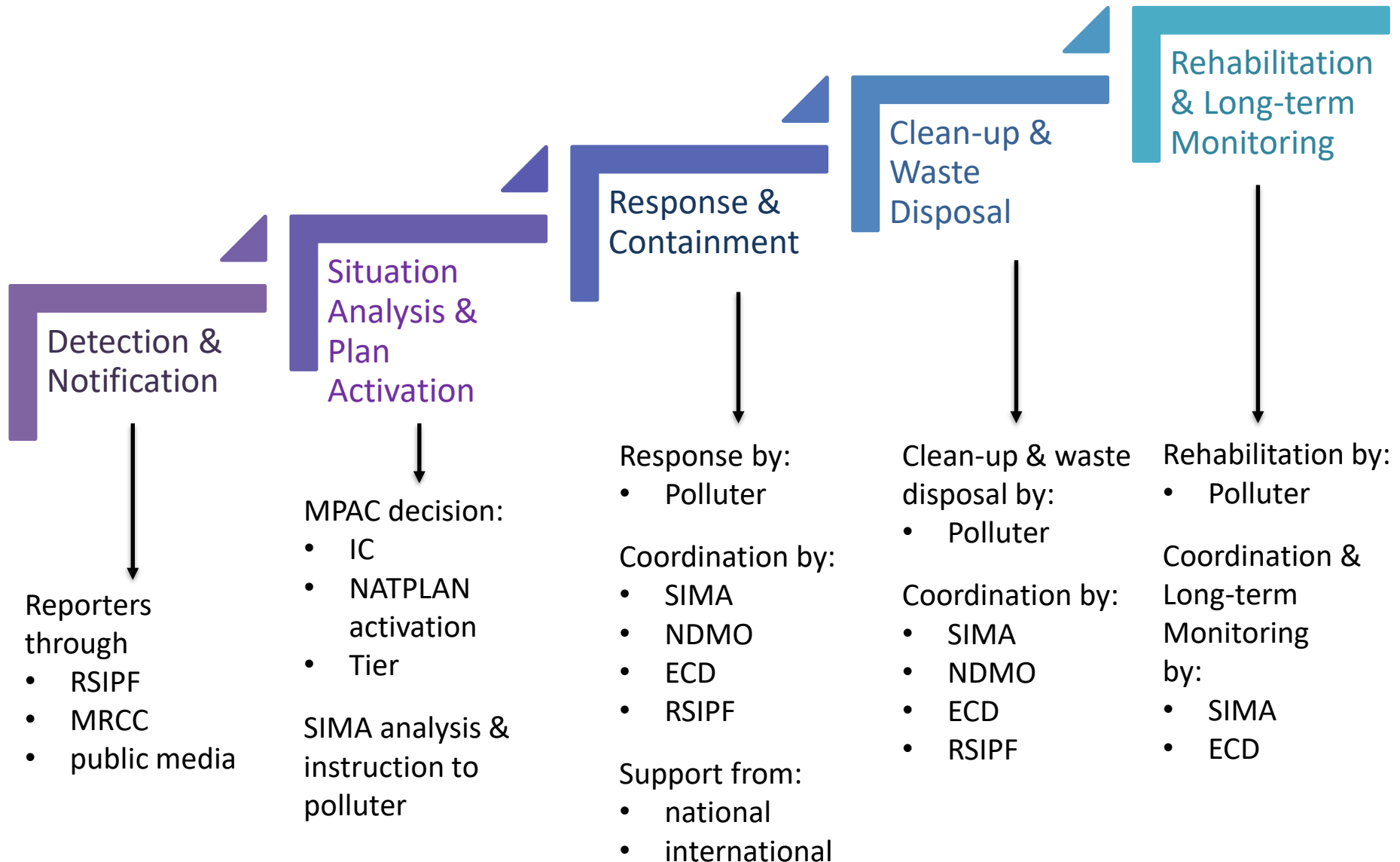
NATPLAN RESPONSE LEVEL



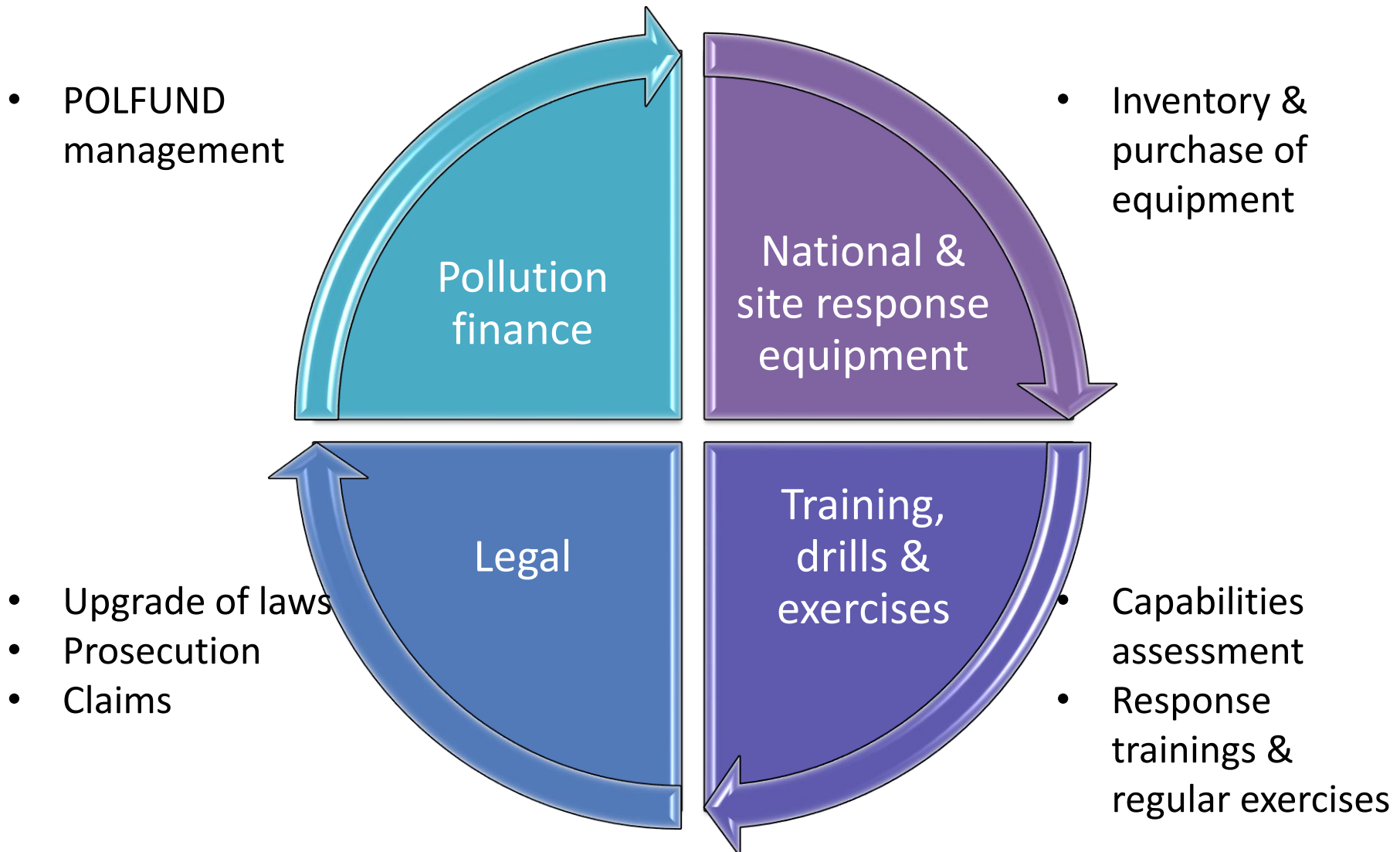
NATPLAN RESPONSE STRUCTURE
